

INDUSTRY QUICK FACTS:

Kentucky's vast network of automotive manufacturing, supplier and service-related companies provide a significant impact on Kentucky's economy, adding \$4 billion annually to the state's GDP. Boasting four major auto manufacturing plants, the state is the third-largest producer of light vehicles in the country, topping more than 1.2 million cars and trucks in 2013. That's an increase of 22 percent over the year before and places Kentucky first in production on a per capita basis.


